BANNERSTRETCH™ FRAME INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

CAUTION

- + Frame edges and springs are very sharp!
- + Use protective gloves and safety glasses during the entire intalation.







ASSEMBLING THE FRAME:

- Unpack frame sides Frame sides are packed in protective packing material DO NOT USE A BOX CUTTER.
 Doing so will result in damage to frame.
- 2. Frame edges and springs are sharp, use care when putting together!
- **3.** Frames will arrive unassembled only the spring mounted covers will be pre-installed. You will need to install the recommended amount of Plastic Spring Tees and the (8) Corner Keys (2) per corner.
- **4. Assemble frame on floor, then wall mount.** NOTE: If installing a frame larger than 48"H x 96"W, it is recommended you mount one frame piece at a time. Use a square and level to make sure your frame is square and level. We recommend installing the bottom frame component first.
 - a. Measure the wall where frame will be installed and establish the distance from the bottom outside edge of the frame to the floor.
 - b. Draw a level line where the bottom edge of the frame will fall. Mount the bottom frame securely using the Snap Toggle Anchors, bolts and washers provided.
 - c. Slide the recommended amount of Plastic Tees with springs into the frame slot. (See parts list) Be sure to install with the hook of the spring facing the wall.
 - d. Insert the Corner Keys (2 per corner), square the sides, and anchor to the wall with the Snap Toggle Anchors, bolts and washers provided.
 - e. Follow steps c. and d. for the top of the frame.

INSTALLING THE BANNER:

- 1. Unroll the banner.
- 2. Secure corners first with Springs into the Grommets.
 There should be (2) Springs per corner Grommet.
- 3. Use the Spring Pull Tool when using the springs.
- **4. For future reference,** there is a label located on the inside cover of the frame containing Graphic Size and Live Area required for your banner.
